RANNOLD HRUDEN - Rannold is always talking about hockey. It's his favorite sport. FAV. SAYING: Whaat?!




DARREN LECLERC - Darren likes to read library books but he doesn't like to return them. FAV. SAYING: I forgot.

ANDREA WEBB - ALIAS: Boom Boom. Can be seen combing her hair or looking in her mirror. Too good for...?


TAMARA WOJCIECHOWSKI - Always talking about T.R. in Sr. High. She can be seen laughing or talking. Good luck with Todd.

STEFAN WOLEJSZO - A nice boy and loved by all! He likes to talk and talk and talk.....




RON YABLONSKY - Can be seen throwing paper at the back of the class. Aiming for Ron?

JESSELINE DAGAMAT - Jess played on the volleyball team. Her favorite past time is reading. The question is to whom is she reading.





ANTONIO DALAYOAN - ALIAS: Baggs. Antonio can be seen walking with the guys or dancing with V.T. in the halls.

JOSEPHINE CABALU - Jose always tells us about her wild week-ends. Were they wild or was she watching All-Star Wrestling?




PETER CZEZOWSKI - Peter left us early in the year for greener pastures.

NANCY MARTIN - Nancy is a cool calm and collected person in school. That's when she is there.




JOHNNY MCLAUGHLIN - Johnny is the world's greatest talker. Some day he'll make the Guinness Records.
